LHFIG meeting - 2nd July 2024

- 1. <u>Purpose of the report</u>
- 1.1 To invite the council to note the current status of the council's outstanding Community Issues.

2. <u>Budget</u>

2.1 The present budget as of 1st July 2024 is £93,866 with £54,020 committed to approved projects, including anticipated contributions from those councils with approved projects. £39,846 remains unallocated to fund new projects in 2024 however Wiltshire Highways has manpower issues in respect of servicing additional projects.

7-23-12 <u>Priority 1</u>	Request for no waiting restrictions at the far end of SBLR to prevent inconsiderate parking preventing householder vehicle access	TRO consultation process commenced by Wiltshire Highways. Consultation document in preparation, publication expected shortly. No further progress, LHFIG demand this TRO is expedited
7-23-20	Concerns about speeding vehicles from the Priory roundabout along the A429 within the 30mph restriction	A traffic survey has been requested along this stretch of road as a precursor to the installation of a SID at the northern part of Burton Hill in the vicinity of the PCC. Speed data report awaited. Data reviewed by WH and PWP and found appropriate for a SID, Highway engineer approved a location by Storey Mews. Item closed.
7-24-03 <u>Priority 1</u>	Improve the visibility to motorists of the zebra crossing by the Priory roundabout in Burton Hill	WH not in favour of installing illuminated posts like those in Tetbury, however LHFIG agreed to incrementally implement improvements ranging from cleaning the posts, replacement high intensity globes and finally illuminated posts. The parish council asked to agree a contribution of up to £3K to cover estimated full project costs. No cost to council for improvements to date, planned globe replacement with high intensity LEDs in due course.
7-24-01	Request for a SID along the C67 east to Tanners Bridge, Milbourne,	Traffic data received and to be reviewed by WH and PWP
