Increased Volume Waste Bins

1. Purpose of the report

1.1. To invite the council to consider purchasing two 100 litre capacity waste bins.

2. Background

2.1. This report should be read in conjunction with Report #11.2 and minute #92 of the 27th November council meeting at which it was agreed to investigate the purchase two higher volume waste bins for replacing the existing bins under the A429 bypass and Foxley Road.

2.2. Presently the bins at both these location are 50 litre capacity and are required to be serviced twice weekly. Given the likely substantial increase in the cost of each service of the council's five waste bins it would seem prudent and cost effective in the long term to purchase higher volume bins at the two locations that require twice weekly servicing in order to reduce the requirement to once a week. The company performing the servicing contract currently has confirmed that larger bins (100 litres) should allow both locations to be serviced once a week. The remaining three 50 litre waste bins do not require upgrading on current usage rates.

2.3. It would seem that the higher volume bins either require fixing to a concrete base or can be purchased with a ballast base.

3. Options

3.1. To continue with the existing waste bins

3.2. To select one of the larger volume options from the list below
